

# FRINGING

## INSTRUCTIONS

**1.** Sew embroidery design to completion. With design still in hoop, turn over and cut through the center of the embroidery to be fringed with a seam ripper or small pair of clipping scissors. This will cut the bobbin thread, releasing the embroidery stitches.



**2.** Once all bobbin threads have been cut, you will be left with two columns of loose top threads with fabric visible through the center. One column is attached with a small satin stitch, and one column is ready to be pulled through to the top side.



**3.** Turn embroidery over. Using a seam ripper or tweezers, gently pull all loose threads through to the top side.



**4.** Once all threads have been pulled through, even out ends with a pair of scissors.
